Managing Director of Okomu oil palm company plc send his condolences to the families of the 6 employees who died in gruesome car accident last week

Monday the 17th of February 2020

On the 14th of February, on the Siluko public Road a minibus carrying 6 Okomu PLC employees had been involved in a head on collision with a tipper lorry.

The Managing Director of the Okomu Oil Palm Company Plc, Dr Graham Hefer, has reported that the gruesome accident on Friday, tragically, claimed six lives from the company -not five, as was earlier reported in the press-. A further three workers were seriously injured when the minibus in which they were travelling collided with a tipper lorry carrying sand and subsequently burst into flames. Apparently one person also died in the lorry. The company Doctor met the 3 employees injured at the hospital and together with his team, he will provide his support to the injured employees until their recovery.

Dr Hefer again expressed his utter shock and dismay at the needless loss of lives, stating that he, his Board, Management, staff, workers and all fellow stakeholders of the Company joined together as one in their thoughts and prayers in sending their heartfelt condolences and sympathy to the families for the loss of their nearest and dearest loved ones. May God grant them the fortitude to bear their losses and the comfort and peace to get through the days ahead.
